April 15, 2013—The Alliance for Workplace Excellence will host their Annual Awards Luncheon on May 15, 2013, from 12 p.m. to 2 p.m. at the Bethesda North Marriott Hotel and Conference Center. Sixtyeight businesses will be honored at the event, and more than 400 area business executives are expected to attend.

The Alliance has recognized the Greater Washington, D.C. area's best places to work for the past fourteen years. This year, AWE will be recognizing organizations from across the United States. The 68 winning companies represent more than one million employees from organizations of all sizes and in all sectors—private, public, and nonprofit. In 2013 the Alliance is proud to recognize the:
